Hello senior parents & guardians,

If your student is going to college next year, an important step in the process begins **TODAY**. October 1. The first step of the financial aid process is to file the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**. The FAFSA is required for any type of federal financial aid and many types of state and college aid. The FAFSA determines a student's eligibility for Federal Pell Grants and guarantees every student an opportunity for federal student loans. *It is recommended that every student file the FAFSA form*.

The FAFSA form became available on October 1st -- which means **you can file the FAFSA now!** Please keep in mind that many college financial aid programs are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis until funds are exhausted.

BEFORE you apply:

- Visit <u>here</u> to set up an FSA ID username & password for the student. One parent also needs an FSA ID username & password.
 - Click <u>here</u> if you need help doing this.
- Gather these <u>documents & information</u> for the student & the parents to use when you apply. This year, senior families will use 2021 taxes to file the FAFSA for the 2023-24 school year. The FAFSA is solely based off 2021 taxes, so you won't have to update the FAFSA with 2022 taxes.
- Check the financial aid <u>priority date at schools</u> to which you your student will apply.
 Every college or university has their own deadline for the FAFSA--some are as early as December 1st.

HOW to apply:

- Visit www.fafsa.gov to complete the online application.
- > Fill out the FAFSA every year you want to be considered for aid.

Visit their website <u>www.ICANsucceed.org/apt</u> to schedule a virtual Zoom appointment, or call their toll-free number, 877-272-4692, to talk to an advisor. A one-on-one FAFSA appointment is free of charge and takes 45 minutes. The closest ICAN office is at the Council Bluffs Iowa Western campus.
