Spring/Summer is a GREAT time to begin mentoring!!!

While many matches start at the beginning of the school year, spring and summer are a GREAT time to get started with mentoring because there are SO many OUTSIDE activities you can do. The summer is also a great time to add some consistency to a child's life when school is out and there is less routine for them.

Some top priorities for mentoring:

- 3rd grade boy who likes wrestling and outdoor activities. Needs a male role model who can focus on him individually.
- 5th grade girl who likes art and sports. Needs some individual attention and help with direction.
- 4th grade (smart, curious, like legos and cars) and Kindergarten (artistic, likes wrestling, legos, cars) brothers need time and someone to do things with them-could be together, but separately would be best!
- 2nd grade girl who likes to be outside and likes coloring and drawing. Need help with reading and needs someone CONSISTENT that she can trust.
