- 2 Ag Teachers, 1 student Teacher
- 9 Edgenuity Courses
- 10 Ag Classes
- 170 Total Enrollments
- 78 Registered FFA Members
- 10 Field Trips for Careers
- Agribusiness Certificate Program
- 4 Iowa Degrees

- Greenhouse non-operational
- Alumni Program: Interest but need a core committee to serve as executive board
- Participation is low across the board from FFA members. Students attend 1 or 2 activities a year.
- Junior FFA lots of interest, but hard to meet and need more connection between 1st and 2nd semester students

Family & Consumer Science Update

- One full time teacher
- Two programs of study with 9 total classes: 1) Family and Community Services, and 2) Cooking and Related Culinary Arts
- Enrollment: 159 throughout the year in 21/22
- Classroom remodeled in 2020
- Choose Iowa Student Culinary Competition: Top 12 entry in 2021
- FCCLA is present; students often lack follow through on projects but do have some consistent community service activities. National FCCLA has introduced new competitive events that will be investigated in coming years, otherwise competition is low.
- Project based learning and community partners have been explored; hard to establish without being stretched too thin





Health Science Update

- ★ One part-time teacher
- **★** Classes:
 - Intro to Health Science
 - CPR and First Aid
 - Medical Terminology
 - o Certified Nurse Assistant
 - And 2 Ignite Courses
- ★ HOSA began 2021-22 School Year
 - Any student who is taking a Health
 Science Course is a member of HOSA
 (35 total; 15 active)
 - 1 community service project + guest speakers frequently
- ★ In progress & a strength
 - Partnership with SMC for Advanced
 CNA and Registered Apprenticeship
 - o Iowa Workforce Development Grant
 - Notable support from SMC






Overall Impressions of the CTE Areas (2022)



1. Are you currently aware of the Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs offered at your student's school?








CLNA Comparative Results: Business and Industry: 2018


Comparative Results: Business and Industries: 2022
