**Free Meals to children 18 and under
June 2, 2025 to August 8, 2025**

SCSD is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. **Free Meals** will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), age or disability, and there will be no discrimination during the course of the meal service. Sites are open **Monday-Friday between 11am – 12:30pm**. Meals will be provided, at a first come, first serve basis, at the sites and times listed below:

High School, Logan School, Sportsman Park, Shenandoah Public Library

Farragut Park will only operate from 10am-10:30am Monday-Friday

-Both meals are offered only as “to go”. This means they are intended to be eaten off site from the service area.

-Since we do not offer a morning service time, breakfast will be available to take for the next morning when picking up the daily lunch.

-Every location will have weekend breakfast/lunch prebagged for pickup every Friday for coverage on the weekend meals.

There will be no service at our locations for the following dates. There will be pre-signup for bulk meal services for families to be picked up only from the High School:

July 3rd-6th (Pick up on July 3, 2025)

July 28th-August 1st (Pick up on July 28, 2025)

Signup sheets will be available on our school website by June 14th, 2025. Cutoff for these dates will be one week, 7 days, prior to its pick up date on each.

Please only go to one site per day. These meals are only to be offered to each child once per day. One lunch and one breakfast
